

Transport of Hazardous Goods

2-Day Course

Comply with relevant legal documentation requirements.

Define legal concepts and explain their responsibilities in terms of the National Road Traffic Act 93 of 1996

Explain the meaning and function of each component on warning signs and documents in terms of SANS 10232 Part 1

Check danger warning placards, specific to the substance loaded on the vehicle for correct fitting on the vehicle.

Carry and place all relevant statutory documents in the designated space.

Apply safety and standard operating procedures during loading and off-loading in terms of SANS 10231

Extract information from relevant sources and utilized to ensure safe handling of classified goods and substances.

Adhere to the duty of the driver before proceeding on route, in terms of SANS 10231

Adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures (relating to the class of substance/goods and related equipment) in order to prepare the vehicle for loading and off-loading.

Wear Personal Protective equipment, suitable to the class of substance during loading and off- loading.

Use safety equipment and procedures suitable to the class of substance during loading and off- loading.

List the nine hazard classes and explain the properties of the class of substance transported.

Explain the concept of compatibility as it relates to dangerous goods.

Apply safety procedures in the event of an incident.

Extract information from the tremcard/treccard or other relevant source/s and utilize it to implement the appropriate response in the event of an incident.

Utilize the correct fire extinguishing equipment in the event of an incident.

Wear Personal protective equipment suitable to the class of substance in the event of an incident.

Use safety equipment suitable to the class of substance in the event of an incident.

Report incidents according to the requirements of SANS 10231

Comply with the requirements of SANS 10231 in terms of behavior on route.

Driving style is adopted in order to maintain load quality and avoid incidents during transportation.

Duties on route in terms of SANS 10231 are adhered to at all times.
